in the academic curriculum, said Prof. Venkatesh.

He also mooted the idea of establishing a directorate under the varsity to infuse a new lease of life to hundreds of private schools and institutions imparting lessons in music and fine arts. This will give an imperus to the learning of fine arts and music and also help realise the larger objectives of the varsity, said Prof. Venkatesh.

He said the present education system was joboriented but devoid of emotional quotient and the need was to harmonise clinical and rational thinking of science with emotional intelligence through pursuit of fine arts.

Delving on modern civilisation Prof. Venkatesh said life was becoming mechanical in the age of machines but society was devoid of the quality of humaneness in the absence of fine arts.

Calling for conserving and promoting traditional music and folk art forms. Prof. Venkatesh said performing artists should also give importance to research activities and strengthen the field through publications.
