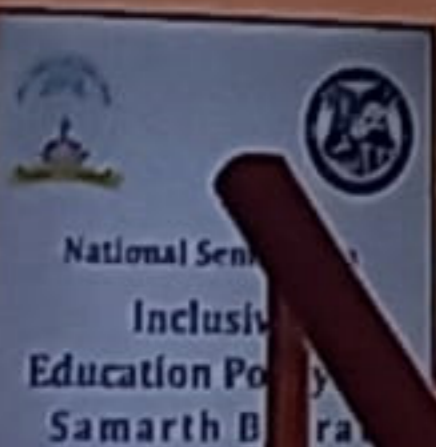

- Education policy refers to the collection of laws and rules that govern the operation of education systems.

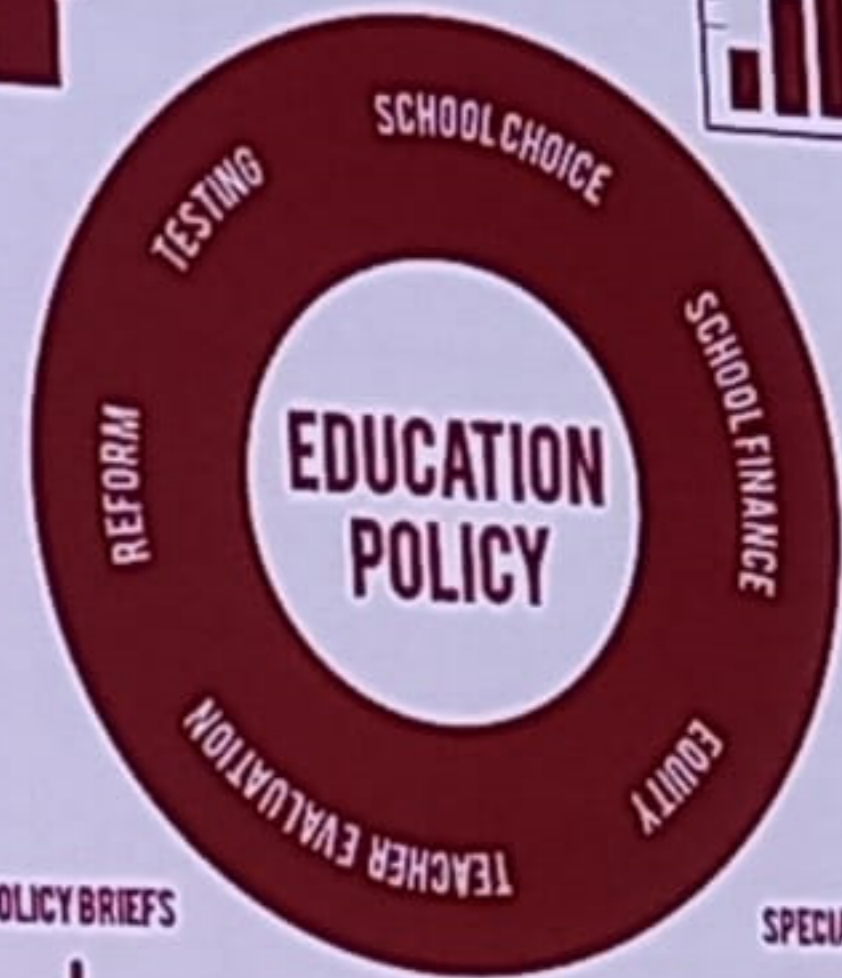
2. Why is it important to study education policy?

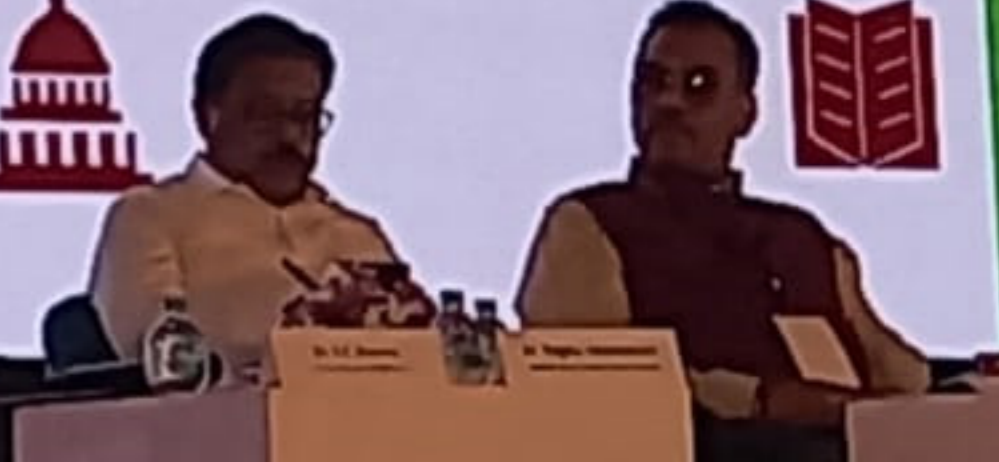
